Sixpenny Success

Sixpenny Special from Sixpenny Brewery in Sixpenny Handley won the festival goers vote as beer of the festival at the 30th Salisbury Beerex in June. Several members of CAMRA visited the brewery to present Scott Wayland with a certificate.

This year Beerex featured 66 different real ales from 33 breweries some local and others from across the country. There was also a number of ciders and a perry on offer. It was a great success with about 1000 people enjoying the selection and the music. Next year Beerex will be on 17th & 18th June so look out for details and do come and enjoy the festival.



On Yer Bike.....

As well as the pub crawls and minibus outings reported here we organise monthly Summer Sunday bike trips to country pubs. Our intrepid cyclists generally leave Salisbury about 10.30 and others drive out to meet them at the chosen pub. This year they ventured to the **Malet Arms at Newton Tony** with a choice of 4 beers, all in good condition with Stonehenge Spire Ale voted the best cycling beer. August saw a visit to the **Black Dog at Chilmark** which has a range of Wadworth beers - the 6X was the favourite. The final trip in September was to the **Horseshoe at Ebbesbourne Wake** with a choice of 5 beers including two from Otter brewery which seems to be making a come back in the area. The return via the **Fox & Goose at Coombe Bissett** allowed the Adnams Southwold Bitter to be appreciated as well.

Fantastic Festivals - The Bank Holiday weekend was awash with beer festivals, I managed several and was able to sample a good range of beers from near and far, listen to some good music and soak up a friendly atmosphere—and some sun. The **Winchester Gate, Yew Tree at Odstock, Bear at Wilton** and **Kings Head at Whiteparish** all met the mark and the **Chough** had good beer and I hope got busier than when I found it.

Guiding you to the Best

The Campaign for Real Ale launched the 38th edition of the Good Beer Guide on September 16th. It features the 4500 pubs with the best real ale in the UK as selected by CAMRA members across the country. It is updated every year by CAMRA volunteers and no one can pay for an entry. It also features a staggering 767 breweries - 4 times the number in existence when CAMRA was founded in 1971. In the past year 76 new breweries have opened and although some have closed there are still 56 more than in the 2010 Guide. In 1971 there were 4 pubs brewing their own beer, now there are 136. This is good news for the beer industry which saw a 5% increase in Real Ale sales against a 2% overall drop in the beer market. We just need to make it easier for beers from these microbreweries to get into pubs so CAMRA is campaigning for new laws on beer supply and the end of uncompetitive pricing practices by some pub companies. You can buy a copy of the Guide online from CAMRA and you can get in on your mobile so you are always able to find the nearest best pub.

Historic Freehouse dating from 1292 is a small, cosy pub with a relaxed bar bistro atmosphere.

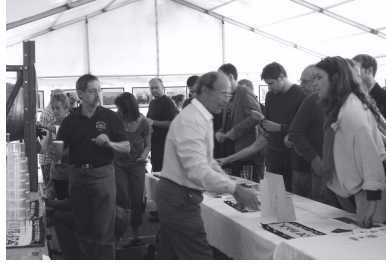
At peak times its best to book a table if you want to dine on our excellent, reasonably priced, authentic Thai food - served 5.30 -10.30
